UNIVERSITY INNOVATION FELLOWS PROGRAM

University Innovation Fellows (UIF) program by Hasso Plattner Institute of Design at Stanford University empowers students around the world to become agents of change in higher education. Fellows create opportunities that help their peers unlock their creative potential and develop the design-centered mindset required to take on complex challenges in today's world.

The application to this program got initiated in the month of May 2022. Applications for the UIF program are team-based by school. Schools new to the UIF program are limited to one leadership circle (max of 4 students) for the first training cohort.

They select students who have a genuine desire to create lasting institutional change that increases the number of students exposed to entrepreneurship, innovation, creativity, and design thinking. The Fellows they select are action-oriented, insightful, mature and passionate. They possess a great, positive attitude as well as strong execution and strategic thinking abilities, and they are willing and eager to learn.

From our college four students from Department of CSE have taken initiative to be part of this program.

They have filled the applications and attended the interview on June 22nd 2022 through online video conference in order to be eligible for the program. The cost of the program is \$4000 of which \$2000 is funded by the college. All the four students got selected for the program on July 12th 2022. The seven week training program started on August 29th 2022 and ended on October 16th 2022. During this training period they are given tasks to complete and present their work.

- Design Thinking approach used for practical and creative problem-solving.
- Landscape Canvas Mapping the Innovation & Entrepreneurship (I&E) Landscape of the school that exists.
- Strategic Priorities Innovative methods identified by the students to improve the Innovation & Entrepreneurship (I&E) Landscape of the school.
- Change Model Canvas Using Mural tool they describe their ideas.
- Story Telling Using presentation and videos they deliver the outcome of their work and discuss with the stake holders of their school.


