Fulfil commitments at the earliest, Chief Minister Naidu tells consortium

The signing of the MoU by the Governments of Andhra Pradesh and Singapore for the development of the Amaravati start-up area by the Amaravati Development Partners (ADP), a joint venture being floated by the Singapore consortium consisting of Ascendas-Singbridge and Sembcorp Pte Ltd., and the Amaravati Development Corporation (ADC), here on Monday took the construction of Amaravati closer to reality.

This agreement for the development of the Amaravati start-up area is part of the broader understanding between A.P. and Singapore for capacity-building, sharing best practices in public administration, strengthening business and cultural links and cooperation in the field of science and technology.

After signing the MoU with Chief Minister N. Chandrababu Naidu here on Monday, Minister for Trade and Industry S. Iswaran said the engagement with A.P. was a key part of the broader strategic partnership between India and Singapore that was established by Prime Minister Narendra Modi and his counterpart in Singapore Lee Hsien Loong through a joint declaration during the Indian leader's visit to Singapore in November 2015. It was for strengthening the existing areas of cooperation and catalysing new ones. Accordingly, Singapore extended its hand of friendship to A.P. and was committed to facilitating the growth of the State.

Wong Kan Seng, Chairman of Ascendas-Singbridge and Neil McGregor, Group President and CEO of Sembcorp Industries, were among those present. Mr. Naidu requested the Singapore consortium to fulfil their commitments at the earliest.




INTERNATIONAL YOGA DAY
