
6. Independence Day Celebrations

7. World Humanitarian Day

World Humanitarian Day is an international day dedicated to recognize humanitarian personnel and those who have died working for humanitarian causes. In this regard, bread packets are distributed to the destitute by 23 volunteers on 19-08-2023 to observe World Humanitarian Day.

Our NSS Volunteers frequently visit them to know what services and facilities are provided to them and to make the elderly feel special and to bring a smile on their face. In this regard, a total of 30 volunteers went to Aasritha old age home in Ramavarappadu and presented fruits and spent some quality time with the inmates on 26-08-2023.



12. JNTU ATL Mentorship Program


51. Awareness on Child Abuse


57. ATL Lab Meet


58. Birth Anniversary of William Shakespeare
