

VIJAYAWADA: The police personnel and other officials on duty may have become tired, but not S.Prabhakar. This Electronics Engineering Illrd year student from PVP Siddhartha Engineering College did not appear a wee bit tired helping senior citizens at Durga Ghat here on Saturday afternoon.

He and his friends have come to the Krishna Ghats to work as volunteers for the Pushkarams. They help an aged couple to reach the tree shade here and alert people about their luggage there.

"We are very proud to have Pushkaram in our city and we feel honored to play hosts," said a proud Prabhakar. As many as 305 students and 25 staff members from his college are working in two shifts - from 8 am to 1 pm and 4 pm to 9 pm at Durga Ghat and Temple, he said.

Hundreds of college students became volunteers for the Krishna Pushkarams. Unmindful of the hot and humid conditions, the students have been playing their part by assisting pilgrims, especially the elders and are ensuring that the pilgrims return home with good memories of their visit to the city. More than 7,000 students and their teachers have become Pushkar Sevaks to assist the police and help the needy.

The district administration has drawn up a plan to utilize the services of nearly 300 engineering students from KL University, VR Siddhartha, PVP Siddhartha, LBRC, GEC etc. for webcasting the ensuing general elections in the district.

Exam time

With the elections scheduled to be held almost coinciding with the examination season for engineering students, the officials are likely to face some difficulty in finding adequate number of the engineering students for live webcast of the election proceedings.

Engineering students belonging to various private colleges in the district have extended their technical assistance by facilitating the online monitoring of the polling process by the election authorities during the gram panchayat elections held last year.

Number of students yet to known

Actual number of students required for the webcasting of the general elections will be known only after the finalisation of the sensitive and hypersensitive polling stations, according to the Revenue Department sources.

The departments concerned are gearing up to enrol and train the engineering students for taking their technical support to webcast the election process in the polling stations classified as problematic, sensitive and hypersensitive.

Contingency plan

In the polling booths situated in remote areas particularly in the tribal pockets where webcasting is not feasible, the Election officials have readied a contingency plan to utilise the services of micro-observers and videographers to keep a track on the polling process.

We have prepared a list of student volunteers who extended their services in webcasting the previous gram panchayat polls, said a Revenue official at the election cell in the Collectorate.

The students from other streams like MCA will be enrolled in the event of shortage of engineering students for web-casting the election process, he said, adding that each student volunteer will be paid Rs 500 honorarium and presented with a certificate of appreciation.
