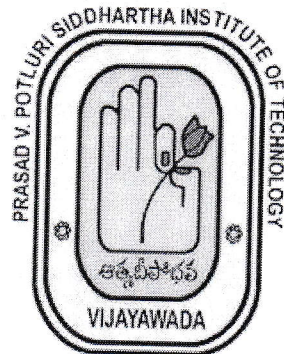


MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

PREAMBLE

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets for the terms and understanding between Prasad V. Potluri Siddhartha Institute of Technology (hereafter called PVPSIT) situated at Kanuru, Vijayawada, and Silicon Andhra to provide Information Technology (IT) and civil Engineering services to a village(Kuchipudi) in Andhra Pradesh.

WHEREAS, Silicon Andhra is engaged in adoption of Kuchipudi village to modernize as a smart village in all aspects to enhance the life style of the villagers. As a Part of this Silicon Andhra needs to design and develop **Village Information System, Health Information System, Agriculture Information System, develop infrastructure like drainage, hospital buildings etc.**, and providing training and consultancy to Government School students.

WHEREAS, PVPSIT is associated with Silicon Andhra and work together in design and development of required web sites and necessary training for their needs. The PVPSIT is also associated in soil testing, surveying and designing of structures and drainage system planned by Silicon Andhra.

WHEREAS, both PVPSIT and Silicon Andhra, now

- Recognizing the importance to develop Information Technology based application for villagers and formers, as well as imparting on field training to the B.Tech. Students, etc.
- Appreciating the need for creation of large reservoir of high quality and useful software applications related to rural development.
- Desiring to club their efforts by pooling their expertise and resources.
- Planning to develop infrastructure

INTEND to form a nucleus for promoting excellent quality manpower in the fields of Information of Technology with special emphasis on web development, database management systems, and related fields and civil Engineering.

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual promises made herein and of good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which both PVPSIT and Silicon Andhra hereby acknowledge, PVPSIT and Silicon Andhra hereby agree to sign a memorandum of understanding (MOU).

SCOPE OF THE MOU

This MOU details the modalities and general conditions regarding collaboration between PVPSIT and Silicon Andhra for enriching, **"IT in rural areas"**, the development of high quality technology in the areas of **Health, Agriculture, and Rural Development and improvement of infrastructure** without any prejudice to prevailing rules and regulations in PVPSIT and Silicon Andhra. The areas of cooperation can be extended through mutual consent.

SCOPE AND TERMS OF INTERACTIONS

Both PVPSIT and Silicon Andhra shall encourage interactions between the doctors, staff, faculty members and students of both the organizations through the following arrangements:

- a) Silicon Andhra may request for design and development of high quality technology in the areas of **Health, Agriculture, and Rural Development** etc. and infrastructure etc.,
- b) Silicon Andhra may request for design and teach a Course or Courses which it deems fit to enhance quality and performance of its employees and people of Kuchipudi. Such Courses maybe run at any mutually convenient premises.
- c) Silicon Andhra may seek assistance/guidance of PVPSIT faculty member/s in product/process modification, modernization, trouble shooting, for the developed applications.
- d) Silicon Andhra may seek assistance/guidance of PVPSIT faculty members in soil Testing, Surveying, Structural designs and design of drainage system.
- e) Would allow the visits of students/ faculty members for full day to provide them with an exposure to real problems of villagers for their daily life.
- f) Students will carry out part of their B.Tech. Projects at PVPSIT depending on the work as per rules of the Institute.
- g) Both PVPSIT and Silicon Andhra will be free to independently carry out follow-up development on the work conducted under this scheme.
- h) In any of the activities mentioned above, wherever financial aspects are involved, amount, payment conditions, etc. would be spelt out clearly before starting the activity.

EFFECTIVE DATE AND DURATION OF MOU

- a) This MOU shall be effective from the date of its approval by authorities at both ends.
- b) The duration of the MOU shall be for a period of two (2) years from the effective date.
- c) During its tenancy, the MOU may be extended or terminated by a prior notice of not less than three (3) months by either party. However, termination of the MOU will not in any manner affect the interests of the students/faculty who have been involved to do their project under the MOU.
- d) Any clause or article of the MOU may be modified or amended by mutual agreement of PVPSIT and Silicon Andhra

This Agreement is entered into on the 30th Day of August 2017 by and between **Prasad V Potluri Siddhartha Institute of Technology (PVPSIT)**, consisting of various technical, non-technical departments leading to degree and/or diploma programs in Engineering

And

Indian Green Building Council (IGBC) which is formed by Confederation of Indian Industry (CII). The IGBC is a consensus not-for-profit organization, representing the building Industry consisting of Architects, Builders, consultants, Manufacturers, Institution and others. The Council members work together to develop Green buildings standards and Guidelines and educational tools that enable the adoption of sustainable building design and Practices.

In order to promote the Green Building Concept and to extend mutual co-operation in some or all the fields of academic and professional endeavour, PVPSIT and IGBC agree to explore opportunities for collaboration in the areas described hereinunder:

1. Provide academic interaction through the special lectures by the members of IGBC.
2. Create opportunities for training of students in the domains of green buildings.
3. Conduct joint awareness programs /workshops/seminars / conferences for all stakeholders including educational institutions, professional bodies and public in general.
4. Seek mutual support and advice in conducting such awareness programs workshops, seminars and conferences.
5. Facilitate Green Building Study Missions
6. Utilize the resources of each other for awareness programs workshops, seminars and conferences.
7. Design, & Development of curriculum on Green buildings jointly
8. Promotion of concepts leading to energy efficiency in buildings.
9. Certify buildings of all the Institutions of the academy as per the IGBC guidelines and processes

10. Bulk registrations for IGBC AP post exclusive Training program for Students & Faculties of Technical departments

Specific agreements made for special events to be carried out jointly, signed by both the institutions or their nominees shall become the Annexure to this agreement. Unless otherwise agreed, each party shall bear their own cost in carrying out any collaboration under this agreement.

This agreement between **Prasad V Potluri Siddhartha Institute of Technology** and **Indian Green Building Council (IGBC)** will be valid when signed by the authorized representatives of both the parties and shall continue for a period of five (05) years from the date of signing. This agreement may be renewed, modified or terminated with the written consent of both the parties during or after the validity of effectiveness.

Either party may publish or advertise the existence of collaborations and collaborative activities under this Agreement.

AND WHEREAS the College is engaged in imparting Academic and Professional education to the students for graduation in various branches of Engineering and Information Technology.



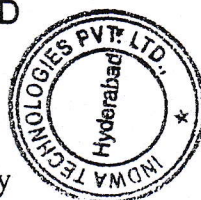
